Talk Title: Experiential collaborative behavioural assessment

Description: The principal element of the session will be to provide an experience for participants working in teams to collaborate in a simulation based on the design and construction of a model of a piece of infrastructure. This will enable team members to undertake a behavioural assessment and/or play the role of an assessor on the day. The exercise will conclude with a review of behavioural lessons learned at a team level only.



Bio: John trained in behavioural psychology and has over 25 years of experience in team and leadership behavioural development, organisational and culture change management and has specialised in partnering/collaboration since 2000. John is a Director in B2B, and, together with team members, delivered the first UK behavioural and collaboration assessment in a regulated procurement in 2001. Since then he has designed and delivered collaboration and behavioural assessments for London Olympics, Ministry of Defence, Nuclear, Rail, HS2, Construction and UK Parliament. John is a Member of the Institute for Collaborative Working (ICW) and he and the B2B have supported both the implementation of BS11000/ISO44001, and on-going consultancy in the fields of behavioural development and monitoring, evaluation and continuous improvement of collaboration in major projects. John has been a Member of the BSI ISO44001 Committee, responsible for developing the new guidance for the implementation of the collaboration standard, to be published in September 2019 under the ISO title of ISO 44002.
