**Talk Title:** Establishing ISO 44001 in Government Organisations – Do's and Don'ts and the importance of getting it right from the start

**Description:** The talk aims to explore the experiences gained from the establishing ISO 44001 in Government Organisations using the MoD as an example.



**Bio:** Bill has extensive experience from the military, industry and academia in developing effective business relationships and collaborations. Bill has held very senior executive-level positions in UK and overseas (US and AUS) businesses (Company Chairman, MD and Plc Executive Director level – Vice President), has been a Visiting Professor at the University of Cranfield Defence Academy lecturing on Defence Technologies, and been a Director of an Aerospace Trade Association where he led the focus on SME Clustering. Bill has provided numerous executive briefings to corporate and operational Boards on the application of BS 11000/ISO 44001 and how it can enhance business performance. As part of his work with the MOD DIO ISO 44001 programme in its Facilities Management (FM) and Major Capital Programme responsibilities, Bill steered the organisation to achieve ISO 44001 certification in May 17 and has provided over 60 one day training courses to circa 1000 staff throughout the UK and overseas. In addition, Bill is leading the ICW support to ICW NZ providing numerous training and briefings and is helping to develop ICW SA and ICW AUS. Bill supports the collaborative research programmes with Warwick University and the ICW Research Forum and has and continues to support and mentors' students in the development of their post graduate thesis.
