Role	Network Participant
Eligibility	Aged 18 years or over. Open to both APM Members or non-member. Non-members must hold an APM registered web account. You can register for an account here. Can join a Network without a formal onboarding process. Agree to APM's Expected Behaviour Policy and Privacy Statement.
Purpose	Network Participants support the Network in achieving its goals and aspirations by contributing to discussions, sharing insights and taking part in wider brainstorming where helpful. They will be invited to attend selected meetings or join conversations as needed, in support of Network priorities. This role does not require the formal commitment or onboarding of a volunteer position. The role is ideal for those who want to stay connected, learn, and contribute on an occasional basis, or who are exploring whether a more formal volunteering role is right for them.
Estimated time commitment	- Participants' will be invited to selected online Network meetings, which on average would be 1hr in duration. - While some Networks may engage Participants more frequently, APM asks that each Network offers at least two opportunities per year for Participants to come together. - There is no expectation for Participants to attend a minimum number of Network meetings – involvement is entirely flexible and based on availability and interest. - Be reachable by email for occasional correspondence with the APM Network Lead and staff.
