Project Management Apprentice of the Year

This category aims to recognise excellence in a Higher or Degree Apprentice undertaking a Project Management standard within the UK.

The category is open to those currently on an apprenticeship programme as well as those who have completed their programme within 12 months of the closing date for entries.

Entrants can either self-nominate or be nominated by their employer.

Entries must take the form of a 1,000 word statement addressing the criteria below and up to two pieces of supporting evidence of no more than one page each which may include images, graphics or links to videos only.

The judges are looking for:
