### Project Management Lecturer of the Year:

This award recognises academics whose innovation and passion have transformed a course and inspired students. Entries will be accepted from institutions, academics themselves or their colleagues, but in all cases the institution must support the submission and student testimonies must be included in the supplementary documentation.

Entries must take the form of a 1,000 word personal statement addressing the criteria below, and up to three letters of support, one of which must be from the entrant's department head, others may be from students or other colleagues. Entrants may also submit up to two additional pieces of supporting evidence of no more than one page each which may include elements of the curriculum, images, graphics or links to videos only.

The judges are looking for:

Criteria	Description	Weighting
Professional pedagogy development	Evidence of how the nominee evaluates and develops their professional progress with regard to teaching.	10%
Student engagement	Exceptional engagement with students and how this has impacted positively in and beyond their academic role. If applicable, explain how this has had an effect beyond their institution in the careers of their students.	30%
Continued commitment to student experience	Evidence of a sustained commitment to advancing and positively influencing the student experience.	30%
Innovation in curriculum development	Evidence of successful innovation in curriculum development	30%
