Project Management PhD or Doctoral of the Year (Herbert Walton Award):

This award recognises an excellent doctoral thesis in a project management related subject awarded during the year. Professional doctorates are also eligible in this category.

Entries should take the form of a 1,000 word personal statement addressing the criteria below, accompanied by the full dissertation as a PDF document and a supporting letter from the entrant's supervisor and/or external examiner including confirmation that the submission has been awarded.

Entrants can be members or non-members of APM. The doctorate must have been awarded in 2019.

The judges are looking for:

Criteria	Description	Weighting
Contribution to theory	Value to academia - The paper should have made significant contribution to project management theory.	30%
Research methodology and methodological rigour	Appropriate use of research methodology to the research question under investigation.	30%
Relevance to practice	Potential for practical applicability of the research or the relevance of the research to project management practice.	30%
Dissemination activities	Demonstration of dissemination activities and potential impact.	10%
