### Contexts and challenges

Weighting: 20%

Describe the background and the health, safety, security and environment (HSSE) requirements of the project / programme / organisation. Are HSSE objectives incorporated in your project / programme / organisations' business plan? What are the HSSE challenges facing your project / programme / organisation? Explain how stakeholders and partners are made aware of their HSSE responsibilities.

### Mitigation strategies

Weighting: 20%

Who is accountable for HSSE in your project / programme / organisation? What are the key performance indicators on HSSE in your project / programme / organisation? What pro-active steps were taken to mitigate any HSSE challenges? Is there a risk register that covers HSSE? Are HSSE risks managed to be as low as reasonably practicable? Do you have an emergency response plan - if so what scenarios have been considered?

### Culture

Weighting: 20%

Does your project / programme / organisation have a HSSE excellence culture? How do you demonstrate commitment to and passion for HSSE excellence? Identify any HSSE objectives that go beyond local / national legislative requirements. Describe actions by your leadership that demonstrate a drive for continuous improvement in HSSE performance. Describe any cultural barriers to HSSE excellence.

### Results and benefits

Weighting: 20%

Describe the HSSE results and benefits of the project / programme / organisation. Why was the performance deemed to be a success from a HSSE point of view? What will the project team(s) take away with them into the next project / programme? Describe the results and benefits for other stakeholders.

### Recognition and lessons learned

Weighting: 20%

How is HSSE excellence recognised and rewarded in your project / programme / organisation? Is there a support structure to positively encourage HSSE excellence? What sanctions are there for non-compliance to HSSE requirements? Have HSSE lessons learnt been captured and shared within your project / programme / organisation? Is there a continuous improvement loop where lessons learnt are fed back to other project professionals in your organisation?
