

## APM Branch Student of the Year Awards 2022 Marking Criteria

APM judges\* are looking for candidates to showcase their achievements with a specific project completed in or out of school, college or university or while on placement.

The candidates should illustrate the project management steps undertaken, the results and benefits of their actions and the lessons learned.

Open to all full-time or part-time students aged 16 or over who have been part of a project in project. Entrants can be members or non-members of APM.

Entries must take the form of a statement of up to 1,000 words addressing the criteria below. Entries can be supplemented with diagrams or images which will not be used in the word count.

The following marking criteria will be used:

<b>Project</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Context for your project or research</li> <li>▪ Decision for selecting this project</li> <li>▪ Outline the stakeholders and/or people involved</li> </ul>	40%
<b>Results and Benefits</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Methods and techniques used to manage the delivery of outputs, outcomes and benefits</li> <li>▪ Challenges encountered and solutions created</li> <li>▪ Overall lessons learned</li> </ul>	40%
<b>Personal achievement</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ How you believe it will help you become a better project professional in the future</li> </ul>	20%

Presentation at APM Branch Awards event

- Present to the audience at the Branch Awards event
- Provide the audience with an insight into your achievements and the project management steps taken.

In the event of extremely close scoring the judges will take the finalists' presentations at the event in to consideration before confirming the winner and runner-up awards.

Duration of presentation to be announced closer to the Award event

Finalists may be asked to give a presentation about their submission, at the Awards event.
