

## Membership Panel Recruitment

The Association for Project Management is looking to expand the current membership panels to review and approve recommendations for Full membership (MAPM) and Fellowship (FAPM). The panel has the authority to make a final decision on entry to membership designations based on the requirements for membership and in line with APM regulations.

Participation in the panel is a voluntary role, APM will pay reasonable expenses in line with our expenses policy should they be required.

The panel will review and make a judgement on entry to APM membership based on the applicant's project experience (MAPM) project experience and personal statements (FAPM). The panel will have a term of two years. MAPM and FAPM applications will be allocated to panel members on a rotational basis based on availability. The expected time commitment is approximately 3-4 hours a month, this can vary dependent on volume of applications.

Currently hold a membership grade of MAPM (for MAPM panel) or FAPM (for either FAPM or MAPM panel)	Essential
Ability and commitment to receive and review applications within a 7-day service level agreement	Essential
Availability to attend initial and ongoing panel training	Essential
Knowledge and awareness of current practice and methodologies	Essential
Currently professionally active	Essential
Ability to demonstrate an impartial / non prejudicial approach	Essential
Experience in mentoring / coaching	Desirable
Experience of providing constructive written feedback and reports on assessment outcomes	Desirable
