Main purpose of the role

As the Solution Architect within APM's Digital Team, you will bring a strong background in designing and implementing scalable, high-performance web solutions, and will be responsible for leading the architecture and design of our web platforms, ensuring the APM website and related web based customer platforms continue to meet customer and business needs.

The website is a key revenue generator for APM; in this role you will not only shape and deliver our dynamic programme for improvement and change, you will also ensure smooth operation of exiting web capabilities and provide support in resolving any production issues.

You will achieve this by:

- Leading the architecture and design of solutions (primarily Umbraco CMS), ensuring they meet business requirements and are scalable, secure, and maintainable.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams, including developers, designers, and product managers, to define and implement technical solutions.
- Aligning complex technology needs with business goals.
- Provide technical leadership and guidance to development teams, ensuring best practices and standards are followed.
- Acting as a bridge between technical and non-technical stakeholders.
- Lead technical execution, taking ownership over code quality, security design, DevOps practices and deployment pipelines.
- Create and uphold engineering standards through code reviews and structured feedback loops.
- Develop and maintain architectural documentation, including system diagrams, technical specifications, and integration plans.
- Stay up-to-date with the latest industry trends and technologies and evaluate their potential impact on our solutions.
- Troubleshoot and resolve complex technical issues, helping to establish APMs Enterprise Architecture Practice, providing support and guidance to the development team.

Success in the Solution Architect role at APM will be demonstrated by the delivery of scalable, secure, and maintainable solutions that meet business requirements and enhance digital platform performance,

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in turn contributing to an excellent, stable online Customer Experience and the success and growth of APM's business strategy and objectives.

This role may evolve to hold line management responsibilities over time.

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- Participate in Agile ceremonies (e.g. sprint planning, retrospectives).
- Support workshops and working groups to understand the technical possibilities and limitations of proposed ideas.
- Guide development teams on the implementation approach for user stories, ensuring architectural alignment and clear separation of concerns.

Solution Delivery

- Lead the development and integration of custom applications.
- Design and document end-to-end technical solutions.
- Ensure quality code is delivered using secure coding practices and maintainable documentation. Drive performance, security, scalability and maintainability of all delivered solutions, proactively identifying and mitigating technical risks.
- Conduct code reviews, enforce development standards and mentor the development team in clean architecture and engineering best practices.
- Implement and optimise CI/CD pipelines and automated deployment strategies.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to ensure all deliverables meet timelines, quality standards and budget constraints.
- Monitor application telemetry and troubleshoot issues, ensuring high system availability and performance.
- Responsible for supporting the resolution of any issues with the existing code base within the production environment.

Technical Leadership

- Serve as a technology mentor and advisor for the development team, promoting engineering excellence and continuous learning.
- Guide teams and wider APM business in the adoption of modern DevOps and agile practices, including continuous integration, delivery and feedback loops.
- Work with SMEs, Business Owners, Product Owners and external vendors to manage backlogs, provide estimates and prioritise enhancements.
- Drive the development and enforcement of engineering processes, architectural governance and quality standards.
- Achieve high levels of engagement and satisfaction from Leadership Team and business stakeholders.
